SAFETY ACE MODEL

ASSESS


Before engaging in any activity on a farm, we must assess the risk of possible harm to ourselves and those around us.

CHANGE

Once possible risks have been assessed, we should change what is needed to ensure the activity's risk of harm is minimised.

ENGAGE

After assessing risks and applying change where necessary we are able to safely engage in the activity. Based on the Safety ACE model, consider two factors you would need to ASSESS and potentially CHANGE before ENGAGING with this type of farming activity.













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DESIGN A POSTER that could be displayed on a farm. The poster should inform workers about safety issues relating to a task relevant to this topic. Include information about the safety factors that need to be considered when:

- preparing for the task,
- carrying out the task,
- the task has been completed.
