Ways to become an Agriculture teacher

1. Complete one of the 14 undergraduate degrees in the agriculture field at UNE, then do a Master of Teaching.
2. Complete an undergraduate degree that is both Education and Agriculture (B Education (Secondary STEM, Bachelor of Teaching K-12 Teaching)
3. Complete a Bachelor of Education (In-service Conversion) if you already hold a degree in something and are already a teacher (of anything).
4. Complete a Master of Education if you already hold an Agriculture or related fields degree, but have not taught before.
